1. PARTICIPANTS (athletes, coaches, judges)

All ATHLETES must be selected by the ITKF Member Organizations and fulfill the following requirements:

- 1. They must be citizens of the represented country.
- 2. They must be registered to competition categories in accordance with their age and sex.
- 3. **They must have ITKF registered black belt (Sho Dan or higher).** In the categories Cadets and Juniors athletes can participate if they hold 1st Kyu.
- 4. They must know, fully understand and be able to compete in accordance with the ITKF competition rules.
- 5. All KUMITE, KO-GO and FUKU-GO athletes are obliged to wear the official ITKF KUMITE GLOVES in accordance with ITKF rules. For hygienic reasons gloves cannot be shared between athletes. Mouth (tooth) guards and groin protector for men are also mandatory. Breast-protection for women is optional, but highly recommended safety equipment.
- 6. They must belong to an ITKF Member Organization which has paid all dues to the ITKF, including membership fee for the year 2022.
- 7. They must present Medical Release and International Health Insurance to Medical Emergencies.
- 8. They must have his/her own international traveling insurance and also personal accident insurance issued by their respective National Federations.

All COACHES must be selected by the ITKF Member Organizations. **Only Coaches registered with ITKF will be allowed to officially represent and coach** athletes during the competition.

All official JUDGES at this event shall be ITKF Registered and Qualified Judges who have participated in and completed the Judges Standardization Course at the tournament site and have been selected and delegated by the ITKF Technical Committee.

ADDITIONAL CATEGORIES: PARA-KARATE

In para-karate athletes are divided into five disability categories:

- 1. blind and partially sighted,
- 2. wheelchair users,
- 3. persons with intellectual disabilities,
- 4. persons with reduced mobility,
- 5. deaf or hearing loss.

If there are less than 3 registered athletes per para-karate category, TOC could merge categories by age and/or disability category. It will be done in coordination with their coaches and support personnel.

Before the competition there will be a part of Judges Standardization Course focused on para-karate judging.

4. COMPETITION RULES

This World Championship will be held in compliance with ITKF COMPETITION RULES. If there are less than 3 registered athletes per category, TOC could merge categories by age.

PARA-KARATE RULES

KIHON

Two competitors (AKA - SHIRO) compete on the tatami in parallel at the same time, facing Sushin. After HAJIME they perform the following techniques (no MATE):

- Gedan Barai left foot front (+ KIAI),
- Oi Tsuki Jodan (5x front + KIAI),
- Age Uke (5x back + KIAI),
- Mae Geri Chudan (5x front + KIAI),
- Gedan Barai (5x back) + Gyaku Tsuki Chudan (right hand, stationary + KIAI)!

At the end, the competitors wait at the final positions, and the judges evaluate them with flags.

KIHON IPPON KUMITE

Two competitors (AKA - SHIRO) compete on the tatami facing each other. After introductory greeting they get closer to a proper distance.

Each of them (first AKA) performs the following attacking techniques:

- Oi Tsuki Jodan,
- Oi Tsuki Chudan,
- Mae Geri Chudan.

At the same time SHIRO performs corresponding defense techniques.

The attacker from the "hachiji dachi" position steps with his right foot back into the "zenkutsu dachi" and performs the "gedan barai" technique with a strong Kiai. He clearly announces offensive technique that will follow. The opponent remains in the "hachiji dachi" position, and the defense is carried out by moving the right leg back, implementing the defense techniques immediately followed by an effective counterattack with the "gyaku tsuki" technique and strong kiai.

The defender uses: "age uke", "soto uke", "gedan barai", "jodan uke" (awase uke). When blocking the "mae geri" technique, the defender should correct the direction of the defense with short slip (yoriashi) to the right at a 45° angle.

At the end of the individual action, the opponents go back in the "hachiji dachi" position, after which the attacker continues to perform the next technique. After AKA finishes all attacking techniques, SHIRO repeats the same procedure as an attacker.

At the end, the competitors wait at the initial positions, and the judges evaluate them with flags.

6. OTHER INFORMATION

An official communication channel with all of the ITKF Member organizations will be WhatsApp (ITKF Global group). If any of the Member organizations could not use it (technical or legal reasons), it should inform the ITKF. In that case we will organize an alternative channel for them.

All official accommodation and travel information will be provided at latest by 31st of May 2022.

All meetings and formal activities will take place at <u>Hotel Kompas</u>, main official hotel of the event.

All competitions will take place at <u>Vitranc sport hall</u>, in walking distance from all of the official hotels.

Registration of the athletes, coaches and officials will be on-line through the official events page. Platform for the registration will be opened at **latest on 10**th **of October 2022.**

All of the World Championship fee payments to the host should be done prior to the event. Payment details will be provided at **latest on 10**th **of October 2022**.

All of the DAN registration, Coaches registration and Judges registration procedures and payments should be done as soon as possible directly to ITKF.

All countries must present national anthem in digital format and two national flags (150cm x 75cm).

In case of Corona restrictions organizers will provide testing facilities for official tests. All of the costs of the official tests are the responsibility of the Member Organization or of the individual participant.
